The minutes of the December 11 meeting were APPROVED.

It was decided to meet in the future in the Pelham Library's History Room, per availability. Scott said he'd reserved the room for February 12.

It was AGREED to include the following items in an annual report to the town, reporting that in 2018, we:

- Maintained eight cemeteries (Arnold, Cook-Johnson, Harkness, Knights, Mt. Lincoln, North Valley, Pelham Hill, and Stevens.
- Reset headstones as needed.
- Dug graves for \_\_\_\_\_ burials.
- Sold two lots.
- Laid out forty-eight 3' x 3' cremation lots at North Valley Cemetery, setting the price at \$100, and stipulating that in such area only flat markers flush to the ground would be permitted.
- Worked with the highway department to develop an area at Cook-Johnson cemetery for green burials.

The Commission will also thank John Trickey in the report for his years of volunteer service mowing the Pelham Valley cemetery.
