That includes working for the Town of Amherst in the Department of Diversity, Equity, & Inclusion for 11 years, the last 2 1/2 years as Assistant Director of the Department.

Persons who attend the training sessions will experience how DEI actually works: what it focuses on, how it addresses discrimination, and what results from following the process. They will be able to decide for themselves how these principles fit their values.
